HOW DID THE FILLIES AND MARES GO?

There were 23 (13% of all races) F/M's races run in June. Of the 23 F/M's races 11 were for 2 yo and 3 yo Fillies so only 12 (6.7% of all races) races were for mares 4 years and older. Of the 155 races where F/M's raced against the "boys" the F/M's only won 17 (11%) of these races and the "boys" 138 (89%) races. Two of the 17 races won by F/M's went to 2yo and 3yo fillies so 15 of these races were won by mares 4 years and older. Mares 4 years and older won 12 F/M's races and 15 races against the "boys" giving a total of 27 (15.2%) races. However, 11 of the 27 races were won by Imported NZ mares so Westbred mares only won 16 (9%) of all races in June.

BREEDER OF THE MONTH (June)

Congratulations to Debra Lewis who bred the 2yo Filly, Eagle Rox (Bettors Delight x Lovera NZ) who won the \$100,000 Diamond Classic by 8 metres in the smart time of 1:58.6ms. Eagle Rox now has had 8 starts for 3 wins, 3 places, stakes of \$91,865 and a best mile rate of 1: 57.3ms. Eagle Rox is from the unraced NZ bred mare, Lovera (Badlands Hanover x Emerald Franco NZ) who is also the dam of the brilliant mare Artemis Belle who has already amassed stakes of \$359,559 from 30 starts (19 wins and 9 places).

WA BASED SIRE (June)

In June 14 WA Based sires produced 36 individual winners of 40 races. Northern Luck had an outstanding month producing 10 individual winners of 12 races. Next best were Rich and Spoilt and Legacy Of Power, both with 4 individual winners. Yankee Sensation and Crouch produced 3 individual winners. Congratulations to the breeders and the connections of the 4 WA sired pacers who won at GP Friday night meetings: Rebecca Amy (Rich And Spoilt), breeder-Harry Capararo; Moonlight Rockhole (Northern Luck), breeder- Royalstar Pty Ltd; Erris Lad (Northern Luck), breeder – GM Harney; Sensational Gabby (Yankee Sensation), breeders – D T Roberts, BJ Anderson, SL Beven, NL Champion and JA Farrell.

WESTBRED HORSES

Westbreds won 81 (45.5%) of the 178 races run in June. At GP Friday night meetings Westbreds won 13 (26%) of the 50 races run for the month. Congratulations to the breeders and connections of the Westbred winners at GP Friday night meetings. Westbred winners have been mentioned elsewhere in the newsletter and the other 9 winners are as follows: Against strong opposition the 2yo filly Eagle Rox (Bettors Delight x Lovera NZ) who was bred by Debra Lewis, convincingly won the \$100,000 Diamond Classic Final in the excellent time of 1:58.6ms. Itsallabout Nicole (Courage Under Fire) and out of the great broodmare, Snookanite, bred and owned by KF Keys and RA Gaunt won well in the smart time of 1:58.0ms. Bettors Icon (Bettors Delight) owner/breeder Brad Stampalia won a 2yo race in 2:00.3ms. The mare, Elite Angel (Safely Kept), breeder- Tarsao Investments Pty Ltd had a good win. The 3yo colt, Daniel John (Blissful Hall), breeder John Bell, had a great win in the very smart time of 1:56.5ms. Owner/breeder Jim Currie had a great win with his top filly Arma Xpress (Artiscape) in the \$50,000 2yo Fillies Westbred Classic. Heez On Fire (Courage Under Fire) breeder – Total Strategy Pty Ltd won the \$50,000 Colts and Geldings Westbred Classic in the good time of 1:57.4ms.
