A highlight of the night will be the "**Stallion Auction**" with some excellent stallions on offer.

- ❖ **Allamerican Ingot**, 10 x 2yo winners and rated 2nd on the Australian First Crop Sires List;
- ❖ **Grinfromeartear** (the sire of 2 x \$3 million plus winners in Mister Big and Mr Feelgood), sired 24 Westbred winners (64.9% winners to starters) in WA in the 12/13 season, including the outstanding 2yo gelding Mister Jadore (14 starts, 6 wins, 6 places and \$156,054 in stakes). Grinfromeartear's Westbred progeny earned \$ 554,456 in stakes in 12/13.
- ❖ **Tinted Cloud**, (by In The Pocket who is also sire of sire of Christian Cullen, Changeover and Courage Under Fire), best known as the sire of the mighty \$3 million earner Smoken Up but also the sire of WA Derby winner Richard Henry 1:49.6 37 wins and \$453305, Hunter Cup runner up Jaccka Clive 1:53.8 \$482463 and our own Tee Pee Village 1:56.2 21 wins \$224407,
- ❖ **Lombo Mandingo**, a well bred sire from the same family as Lombo Pocket Watch and Daintys Daughter. From limited opportunities he is the sire of the WA 2yo filly, Maddy White, 12 starts, 3 wins/5 places and stakes of \$27,911 in 12/13.
- ❖ **Cam's Fool**, a well bred half brother to USA 2YO Colt of the Year and Breeders Crown Champion "I Am A Fool". Neven Botica tells us that his foals are very impressive. He is by the sire of sires, Cam's Card Shark (sire of Bettor's Delight, Four Starzzz Shark, Roll With Joe, Village Jolt, Riverboat King, Million Dollar Cam and Aces N Sevens)

Funds raised by WASBA from events such as the Gala Dinner and the annual Stallion Raffle are put back into the industry in the form of stakes or breeder bonuses for fillies and mares and Westbred races in WA. The Golden Girls Mile, the Breeders Stakes and the Daintys Daughter Classic owe their beginnings to WASBA and are now all permanent fixtures in the WA calendar. This year's sponsorship includes the \$12,000 Virgil Queen Celebration Pace for C2+ M0 Westbred mares at Northam (the inaugural race was run 13 August and won by 5yo Beautiful Night), the \$14,999 Bob Humphries Memorial Pace (see separate article) and a race to be run at Harvey in early 2014.

The more we raise, the more we can do to support breeding and the harness racing industry in WA.

EPONA MARES CREDIT SCHEME

Don't forget that unless your filly or mare has already reached \$5,000 in credits, and regardless of where she was born, she is still earning Epona credits for her future breeding career whenever she wins a race in WA. To date there are only four Westbred F/Ms who are now ineligible for future credits, having reached the \$5,000 bench mark – Lucky Diva, Im Bella Jay, Highest Royalty and Artistic Copper. Remember that unused credits stay with the mare regardless of changes of ownership and the Credits can only be redeemed if the mare is served in WA.

Since the Epona Mares Credit scheme commenced earlier this year F/Ms have won 209 races and RWWA has contributed \$163,756.50 in Epona Credits.

WASBA BOB HUMPHRIES MEMORIAL WESTBRED MARES PACE.

This is the 2nd of three C2+ MO Westbred Mares races WASBA is sponsoring and will be run by the Bunbury Club on their Cup night, Saturday 7th December 2013. The race will be run over 2100m for stakes of \$14,999.

If you have a Westbred mare (C2+ MO) make sure you nominate for this race. You can check out the details of this race in the December Racing Programme in the next issue of Racing Ahead. It's a great family night at the Bunbury Trotting Club so, even if you don't have a horse racing on the night, put the family and picnic basket in the car and head down to the Bunbury Track. Companion sire is WA Golden Nugget winner **BONAVISTA BAY (1:56.3, \$503,299).**

WA BASED SIRES

August was not a good month for WA based sires with the progeny of 15 WA based sires only winning 29 (17%) of all races. Northern Luck and Rich And Spoilt were the best of the WA sires with 4 individual winners. The progeny of WA based sires won 5 races at GP Metro stakes meetings. Has the Answers (Legacy Of Power) breeder Les Coulson, won 2 races. He won a FFA over 1730m in a very quick mile rate of 1: 53.8 and paid \$18.90 for the win. He followed this up with a win (this time a \$1.30 fav.) in another FFA over 2130m in 1:56.5. Another Vinnie (Legacy Of Power), also bred by Les Coulson, won a 3yo race over 2130m in a quick 1:57.2 and paid \$27.80 for the win. Four Legged Frenzy (Northern Luck) breeders W M Scott and J P Sangalli, won a 3yo fillies race over 2130m in a smart 1:58.1 and paid \$12.30 for the win. Kiss Chasey (Yankee Sensation) breeder P D Webster, had a good win in a C2+ Westbred Pathway race.

BREEDER OF THE MONTH

Congratulations to Reg Smallacombe who bred the 5yo gelding, Snoopys Rebel (Artesian x Alabar Belle). Snoopys Rebel won 2 races in August, a CO race over 2569m and a C0 to C2 race over 2100m in what was his best mile rate of 2:00.7ms. His record now stands at 30 starts for 3 wins, 8 places and stakes of \$18,680. Reg bred Snoopys Rebel from the lightly raced broodmare, Alabar Belle, who belongs to owner/breeder Tom Francis. Alabar Belle has already provided Tom Francis with the good mare, Lucky Drew (Dr Drew) whose record stands at 9 wins, 17 places and stakes of \$54,934. Alabar Belle is by D M Dilinger out of the race winning mare Lukarly whose best foal is the mare, Adelaide Belle (Lucky Cam). Adelaide Belle, who won a 2yo Fillies Sires Series Final, has a record of 19 starts for 5 wins, 8 places and stakes of \$60,206. In the breeding barn Adelaide Belle has produced good race performers in Joshuas Reign (Barnett Hanover) – 7 wins, 18 places and stakes of \$43,468 and Libra Belle (Dr Drew) – 10 wins, 11 places and stakes of \$62,846.

2 MINUTE BADGES

These badges are awarded to breeders who have bred horses who have won races in a mile rate of 1:59.0 or less. A list of all breeders eligible for a badge(s) is included with this newsletter. Again, those eligible for these badges will only receive them if they attend the Awards Dinner or arrange for their badge(s) to be collected by someone at the Dinner. If you would really like one of these 2 minute badges this will be your last chance to get one as they will be discontinued in the 13/14 season. The WASBA committee will try to come up with some other Award to replace the 2 Minute Badges which have not been as popular with industry members as we thought they would be.

WESTBRED WINNERS

Westbreds won 71 (41.8%) of all races in the month of August. These 71 wins consisted of 42 wins (Westbreds by Imported semen) and 29 wins (Westbreds by WA based sires). Westbreds only won 11 (22%) of the races at GP Metro Stakes meetings so Imports continue to dominate racing at these meetings. Of the 11 races won by Westbreds, 6 were by Imported semen and 5 by WA based sires.

Congratulations to the breeders and connections of the 11 Westbred winners at the GP Metro Stakes meetings. Those that haven't already been mentioned in the WA based Sires and F/Ms sections are:-

- ❖ Nipper Hall (Blissful Hall) breeder Ashley Kemble, who won a MO+ SS race;
- ❖ El Machine (Elsu) breeder Ian Davie, who won a C2+ Pathway Series races over 2536m in a fast mile rate of 1:58.5;
- ❖ the 2yo gelding Hugh Victor (Artesian) breeder Steve Johnson had a great win over 1730m in the outstanding mile rate of 1:56.9. Hugh Victor is a full brother to David Hercules;
- ❖ Smooth Caesar (Rustler Hanover) breeder Steve Johnson who won a C2+ Westbred Pathway Series race over 1730m in 1:57.8.

WESTBRED RACES

In August 19 Westbred (or "Westbred preferred") races were programmed and 20 run as one race was split into 2 races. Sixteen (16) of these races were "Restricted to Westbreds" (including 1 F/M race) and 4 were "1st Preference to Westbreds" (including 3 F/M races). One of the "1st preference to Westbreds" F/M races was won by a NZ bred mare. So of the 20 Westbred races, 4 were for F/M and the other 16 were Westbred open races, 3 of which were \$8,000 Pathway Series races.

In September and October 80% of races previously restricted to Westbreds are now preference to Westbreds which is a change that does concern WASBA but is intended to ensure full fields. Generally where there is preference to Westbreds and insufficient Westbreds are nominated, the balance of the field is being selected in reverse points score order. However, some of these races have already been run and won by non-Westbreds. ***So remember to enter your Westbreds in the "1st Preference to Westbred" races to ensure full fields of Westbreds and thus guarantee that the stakemoney goes to Westbred owners and breeders as is intended in these races! Let us know what you think about the change.***

The first series of \$8000 heats for the \$14999 Westbred Final have been completed (6, 13 and 20 September) with good nominations, especially for the 2nd and 3rd heat. The racing was close and turnover was as good as other races on the night. WASBA hopes that this will be the first of many Westbred race initiatives that allow Westbred horses to win good stakes for only C class penalties. WASBA will try to advise members when these races are programmed. Please support these races to ensure they continue to be programmed.

HOW DID THE FILLIES AND MARES GO?

In August 23 (13.5% of all races) F/Ms races were programmed with 2 x 2yo filly races falling over but another F/Ms race was split so 22 F/Ms races were run for the month. Ten of the F/Ms races were won by Imports and 12 by Westbreds (8 by WB mares and 4 by WB 2yo and 3yo fillies). Overall Westbred F/Ms won 27 races (12 F/Ms races and 15 open races) which is 15.8% of all races. Westbred mares won a total of 16 races (8 F/Ms races + 8 open races) which is only 9.4% of all races.

Westbred F/Ms managed only 3 wins at GP Metro stakes meeting s. The 3yo filly, Four Legged Frenzy, is mentioned in the WA BASED SIREs section and the other two are Vanesia (Life Sign) breeder D J Maloney and W Clyde who won a 2yo fillies race in 1:59.6 and Loving You (Art Major) breeder Neven Botica who won a 2130m fillies race in 1:59.0.
