Funds raised by WASBA from events such as the Gala Dinner and the annual Stallion Raffle are used to provide stakes or breeder bonuses for fillies and mares and Westbred races in WA. In the past, WASBA has sponsored races such as the Golden Girls Mile, the Breeders Stakes and the Daintys Daughter Classic which are now all permanent fixtures in the WA calendar. This year WASBA, with Allwood Stud Bullsbrook, sponsored the \$12,000 Virgil Queen Celebration Pace for C2+ M0 Westbred mares at Northam on 13 August, won by 5yo Beautiful Night in a very exciting finish. Other sponsorship is currently in the planning phase for introduction in 2014 (see article on the race). *The more we raise the more we can give back to the harness racing industry in WA.*

## **OWNER ASSISTANCE PACKAGE**

Ever since the Owner Incentive Package (OIP) was axed WASBA has been pushing for it to be reinstated as per the wishes of our members. Your committee has communicated the WASBA position, with regard to the reintroduction of an OIP, to RWWA on numerous occasions. That position is:-

***"That all unplaced horses in a race should receive some payment because of the ever increasing costs associated with getting a horse to the track. The amount paid to each unplaced horse would depend on the money available to fund such a scheme, but this money should not come from stake money".***

In the August /September Racing Ahead magazine Manager Harness Racing **Barry Hamilton** released news of a suggested initiative that will be part of a broader OAP, whereby:-

***"reducing the stakes by 1% for horses finishing first to sixth the savings generated will provide enough money to pay \$65 per horse down to last place".***

Unfortunately under the current proposal the money to fund this initiative in the OAP will come from Stake Money which is not WASBA's preferred option. **WASBA will continue to liaise with Barry** to obtain the best outcome. We do however, **commend Barry for pursuing this very positive initiative which will be a great help in defraying ever increasing costs to owners, many of whom are also breeders.** From what we hear this payment back to last will be introduced by RWWA in the 2014/15 season.

## ***EPONA MARES CREDIT SCHEME***

Congratulations to the Owners and Breeders of the 143 F/Ms who have earned Credits from when the scheme started to the end of July 2013. At this point in time **RWWA's contribution to the Epona Mares Credit Scheme is \$143,625.50**. On behalf of all breeders in WA WASBA congratulates RWWA on the introduction this fantastic scheme and their continued support of the breeding industry in this State. **Four Westbred F/Ms have reached the \$5,000 bench mark – Lucky Diva, Im Bella Jay, Highest Royalty and Artistic Copper**. Other Westbreds doing well are **Pure Royalty, Deluxe Edition and Centrefold Angel who have each banked in excess of \$3,000 in Epona credits**. Other non -Westbred F/Ms who are doing well are **Generally Outspoken NZ (over \$4,000)** and 3 that have **banked in excess of \$3,000 are New Zealand bred Askmenow and Slick Bird, and Victorian mare Aussie Made Lombo**. Attached is the full list of F/Ms who have earned Epona credits up to the end of July 2013, remembering that the Credits can only be redeemed if the mare is served in WA.

## ***BREEDING SEASON***

With the breeding season just around the corner, don't forget to keep an eye out for offers from the stud farms. New stallions and moved stallions this year include (and this list is nowhere near complete):

- **TINTED CLOUD (Sire of the mighty Smoken Up)** has moved to **Allwood Stud in Bullsbrook WA** and will be companions sire for **ALLAMERICAN INGOT** and **Lombo Mandingo** (from the same family as **Lombo Pocket Watch** and **Daintys Daughter**);
- **MR FEELGOOD** 1:49 \$3,366,157 (Grand Circuit, Interdominion, LittleBrown Jug, Group 1 winner) is at Yirribee Stud along with **LOMBO POCKET WATCH** and **LANERCOST**;
- **STUNIN CULLEN (Christian Cullen's richest son) p3, 1:54.1** 2011 Hunter Cup winner (beating Smoken Up, Im Themightyquinn, Karloo Mick and Smiling Shard) and winner of \$1,384,863 is available through Bred In The Blue, as is **LANERCOST** (by Courage Under Fire) and **LINCOLN ROYAL** (known as Sir Lincoln in New Zealand);
- **SMILING SHARD** 1:53.7 \$1,089,831 is standing his first season at Alabar Farms Australia. Alabar also has standing in New Zealand the highly credentialed first season US stallion **BETTERTHANCHEDDAR** 1:48 \$1,636,086 and the excitement machine **AUCKLAND REACTOR** 1:52.9 \$1,759,374
- **WE WILL SEE** 1:47.4 \$2,549,409 Canadian Pacing Derby, USA Championship and Ben Franklin Pace winner and fastest US pacer in 2011 is standing his first season at stud at Warwick Stud Victoria.

## ***WASBA / ALLWOOD STUD FARM VIRGIL QUEEN WESTBRED MARES CELEBRATION RACE***

This was the first of 3 Westbred Mares races WASBA will co-sponsor over the next 12 months and was run at Northam on Tuesday 13<sup>th</sup> August for \$12,000 Stakes plus Trophy, Rug and Garland.

The winner was the 5yo mare, **Beautiful Night (Western Terror x P JS Dream NZ)** who, from well back in the field, finished fast down the outside of the home straight to grab a well deserved win. **Congratulations to trainer Peter Tilbrook, driver Chris Lewis and owner/breeder Neven Botica**.

**WASBA would like to thank Allwood Stud for co-sponsoring this race and for taking their three Stallions (Allamerican Ingot, Lombo Mandingo and Tinted Cloud) to Northam**. The stallions were a real feature at the race meeting and certainly created a lot of interest. **Many thanks to the Northam Club for their strong support of the race and the fantastic hospitality extended to the WASBA representatives on the night**

**WASBA is now working closely with the Bunbury Club and hopefully the second of these Westbred Mares races (for C2+ MO Westbred mares) will be run on Bunbury Cup night in December 2013**. Due to great support from the Bunbury Club the stake for this race will be \$14,999. Look for details in the next Racing Ahead or WASBA newsletter.

## **WA BASED SIREs**

Over the past 2 months WA based Sires have sired 53 individual winners of 63 races. Progeny of **“Northern Luck”** did very well with 17 individual winners of 20 races. Next best were **“Parsons Den”** with 5 individual winners of 7 races, **“Allamerican Ingot”(by Western Hanover)** 4 individual 2yo winners of 5 races and **“Legacy Of Power”** with 4 winners. Unfortunately the stallions Northern Luck and Legacy Of Power are deceased and Parsons Den is now standing in NSW. **“Allamerican Ingot”** (Allwood Stud at Bullsbrook) is doing particularly well with only his first crop of racing age. So far he has **sired 10 individual winners of 14 races** and currently lies **9<sup>th</sup> on the National Top 20 2YO Pacing Sires list and 2<sup>nd</sup> on the National First Crop list**. His top 3 winners, all fillies, are **Highest Royalty** \$69,795, **Pure Royalty** \$38,609 and **Racey American** \$29,456. **Allamerican Ingot** is well worth consideration when breeders send their mares to the breeding barn this season.

Over the past 2 months the progeny of WA based sires have produced some good wins at GP Friday night meetings.

- **Highest Royalty (Allamerican Ingot), breeder Royalstar Pty Ltd, won the \$100,000 Group 1 2YO Fillies Diamond Classic Final.**
- **Lucky Diva (Northern Luck), breeder Royalstar Pty Ltd, won the \$100,000 Group 1 3YO Fillies State Sires Final by a good margin in a record 1: 58.2 mile rate beating the previous record of 1:58.8.**
- **Another Vinnie (Legacy Of Power), breeder Les Coulson, easily won the \$100,000 Group 1 3YO C/G's State Sires Final clearing away from the rest of the field to win by 28 metres in the race record breaking time of 1: 58.1ms.**

In June GPHR staged 4 x \$25,000 races, 2 x 2yo Sires events and 2 x 3yo Westbred events. This was a great initiative and certainly appreciated by owners / breeders in WA. The 2yo events were a great advertisement for **Allamerican Ingot** as his progeny won both races. The Westbred colt, **Terraforce**, breeder Graham Cox, won the 2yo C/G's event and **Pure Royalty**, breeder Royalstar Pty Ltd, won the 2yo Fillies event. **Pure Royalty** also won a \$17,000 2yo Fillies race. **Wilkins Lucinda** (Rich And Spoilt), breeder Harry Capararo, won the 3yo Fillies Westbred race in a slick 1: 57.3 mile rate over 2130 metres. Other winners by WA sires at GP Friday night meetings were **Has The Answers** (Legacy Of Power), breeder Les Coulson, won a \$21,000 FFA. **Erris Lad** (Northern Luck), breeder G M Harney, who had a good win over 2503 metres in 2: 00.7. One you should keep an eye on is the 3yo gelding **Northern Fox** (Northern Luck), breeder Royalstar Pty Ltd, who scorched over 1730 metres at a recent GP Monday day meeting in a slick 1 : 56.8ms mile rate.

## **BREEDER OF THE MONTH – June**

Congratulations to **Patrician Park and co-breeders B S Coffey and J M Boag** who bred the outstanding 2yo gelding, **Mister Jadore (Grinfromeartoear x Crystal Journey NZ)**. In June Mister Jadore won his Heat of the Pearl Classic and then ran 2<sup>nd</sup> in the Final. The win in the Pearl Heat was Mister Jadore's 6<sup>th</sup> win of the season and his other wins include the **Heat and Final of the \$100,000 Group 1 Sales Classic** and the **\$50,000 Champagne Stakes**. Mister Jadore's record now stands at 14 starts for **6 wins, 6 places, mile rate of 1:58.9ms and stakes of \$158,054**.

**His NZ bred dam, Crystal Journey** (Sands A Flyin x Silky Atom NZ) was a good race mare with a record of 11 wins, 26 places and stakes of \$113,185. She has 2 foals of racing age, **Baptism Of Fire (Ponder)** – 16 starts for 1 win and 2 places and of course **Mister Jadore**. Her 3<sup>rd</sup> foal is a yearling colt by Sportswriter who, if in the Yearling Sales next year, should attract plenty of attention. **The 2<sup>nd</sup> Dam, Silky Atom NZ** (Sokys Atom x Silk And Satin NZ) was unraced but has produced 2 good foals in **Crystal Journey NZ** (race record as above) and **Revamy NZ** (10 wins & \$58,848). **Third Dam Silk And Satin NZ** (New York Motoring x Satin Lining USA) has a racing record of 7 wins, 4 places and stakes of \$82,684 and the best of her progeny is **Galactic Council NZ**, 29 wins, 85 places, mile rate 1: 52.0ms and stakes of \$224,444. **The 4<sup>th</sup> Dam, Satin Lining USA** produced 2 top pacers in the gelding, **Best Of British** (stakes of \$221,264 & mile rate 1: 54.8ms) and the mare **Princess Silk** (stakes of \$174,575 & mile rate 1:56.8). **Wow, what a family Mister Jadore come from! There are certainly more exciting times ahead for the breeders of Mister Jadore as their broodmare, Crystal Journey, drops more foals.**

## ***BREEDER OF THE MONTH – July***

Congratulations to **Royalstar Pty Ltd (manager Ross Torre)** who bred the exciting 3yo filly, **Lucky Diva (Northern Luck x Royal Diva)** who won the **\$100,000 Group 1 Fillies State Sires Series Final** by a clear 8 metre margin in the **record breaking mile rate of 1: 58.2ms**. Lucky Diva's record now stands at **25 starts for 4 wins, 7 places and stakes of \$102,732**. As a 2yo Lucky Diva had 6 starts for just a 3<sup>rd</sup> place, but she certainly hit her straps as a 3yo. **Lucky Diva's dam**, who was also bred by Royalstar, Royal Diva (Safely Kept x Laras Luck), was lightly raced having only 6 starts for 1 win. She has 3 foals of racing age (one is a 2yo) for the one winner, Lucky Diva. **The 2<sup>nd</sup> Dam**, Laras Luck (Maple Lanes Strike x Racy Princess), was also lightly raced having only 14 starts for 1 win and 7 places. In the breeding barn she produced 13 foals for 9 winners. The best of her progeny are, West Coast Wizard (Windshield Wiper) 13 wins & 10 places, Royal Chandon (Chandon) 5 wins & 6 places and the mare Zinobar (Northern Lights) 5 wins & 11 places. **It has been a great 2 months for Royalstar Pty Ltd** because in the 2YO Fillies Diamond Classic (run in June) the first 2 fillies past the post were bred by Royalstar, Highest Royalty (Allamerican Ingot) and Elite Royalty (Jet Laag). Also in June the filly, Pure Royalty (Allamerican Ingot), won a \$25,000 2YO Fillies Sires race.

## ***WESTBRED WINNERS***

For the months of June and July **Westbreds won a total of 145 (43.7%) of all races** run over this 2 month period. **Only 26 (17.9%) of these 145 races were won at GP Friday night meetings**. This means that out of the **80 races run at GP Friday night meetings Westbreds won 26 (32.5%)** and Imports 54 (67.5%) of these races.

**Congratulations to the breeders and connections of the 26 Westbred winners at the Friday night meetings**. Many of these winners have been mentioned in the WA Based Sires and Mares section of this newsletter. Those who haven't been already mentioned are:- **Swagga (Live Or Die)**, breeder **Seahorse Racing Stables**, who had a good win in the **\$100,000 Group 1 2YO Pearl Final**; **Kimba Bay (Artistic Fella)**, breeder **Doug Sutton**, won the **\$100,000 Group 1 2YO C/G's Westbred Final** in a smart 1: 58.9ms mile rate; **Heez On Fire (Courage Under Fire)**, breeder **Total Strategy Pty Ltd**, won **3 races**, the **\$25,000 C/G's Westbred** race in 1: 57.6ms, a 3yo race at Northam in 1: 58.7ms and a **CO race at Pinjarra over 1684 metres in a sensational 1: 54.7ms mile rate**; **Daniel John** (Blissfull Hall), breeder **John Bell**, won an M2 in a quick 1:56.1ms mile rate; **Copagrín** (Grinfromeartoeaer), breeder **M J, S L & I R Howie**, had a good win in a MO race; **Eddys Entourage** (Attorney General), breeder **Harry Capararo and B & C P Colangelo**, won a Pathway race in 1: 56.7.

## ***WESTBRED RACES***

In the 2 month period (June/July) **36 Westbred races were programmed but 37 run as one race was split into 2 races – 33 races had the condition "Restricted to Westbreds" and 4 races "Preference to Westbreds"**. Only 2 of the Restricted to Westbred races were run with less than full fields (fields of 8 and 9 starters). **One of the Preference to Westbred races was won by a NZ Import – Owners/Trainers please don't let this happen again, enter your Westbreds for these "Preference to Westbred" races so as to exclude non- Westbreds from these races.**

The 37 Westbred races were run under the following categories:- WB FM's races (6), WB 2yo Fillies races (3), WB 2yo C/G's races (3), WB Open Pathway races (4) and WB Other Open races (21).

## ***WASBA STALLION RAFFLE***

The WASBA Stallion Raffle has now closed. We thank all the breeders and others who purchased tickets in this year's Raffle, which had as first prize a service to either Art Major or Rock N Roll Heaven or Mach Three and \$4000 worth of vouchers towards service fees at Alabar Farms and Pepper Tree Farm. ## ***HOW DID THE FILLIES AND MARES GO?***

Over the past 2 months (June & July) **F/Ms won a total of 81 (24.4%) of all races** run over this period. Fillies won 41 and Mares 40 of these races. **Westbred fillies were successful in 29 (70.7%) of the 41 races won by fillies. Westbred mares, however, were only successful in 19 (47.5%) of the 40 races won by mares.** Of the 19 races won by Westbred mares 10 were in F/M's races and 9 were in races "open" to both males and females. So, Westbred mares only won 19 (5.7%) of the 332 races run over the months of June and July. **WASBA is still looking to improve winning opportunities for mares, Westbred mares in particular, but in saying this we appreciate efforts by RWWA that have, to date, certainly given more Westbred mares a chance to earn money and just as importantly, EPONA Credits.**

**At GP Friday night meetings for June and July F/Ms won 18 (22.5%) races with Westbreds winning 11 of these races. Of the 11(13.8%) races won by Westbred F/M's, 8 went to Westbred 2yo and 3yo Fillies and only 3 to Westbred Mares.** Of the 8 Westbred Fillies races won at GP Friday night meetings the following were mentioned in the WA Based Sires section – **Pure Royalty** x 2 races, **Wilkins Lucinda**, **Highest Royalty** and **Lucky Diva**. The other filly winners were **Im Bella Jay (Kenneth J)**, breeder **D M & R A Kaptein**, who had a great win in the **\$100,000 Group 1 2YO Fillies Westbred Final**, **Miss Atomic** (Grinfromeartoear), breeder **Neven Botica**, won a 3yo Fillies race over 1730 metres in a fast 1: 57.2 mile rate and **Deluxe Edition** (Jet Laag), breeder **Denise Trobe** and **A M Staltari**, won a 3yo fillies race over 2130 metres in a solid mile rate of 1: 58.0ms. The 3 Westbred Mare winners were **Her Mattjesty Mulan** (Royal Mattjesty), breeder **Allwood Stud Farm**, who won a F/M's MO race; breeder **K J F, K T & H R Charles**, won a F/M's race over 1730 metres with **Ticket To Nowhere** (Blissfull Hall), in a fast 1: 56.5 and a Pathway Series race over 2130 metres with **Luck Has It** (Northern Luck).in a slick 1: 56.7.
