## ***WHERE ARE THEY STANDING?***

We will try to keep you informed of stallion movements and arrivals, but not all can be listed so keep an eye open on the HRA, harness and stud websites. You can also check out our Breeding and Links pages at [www.wasba.com.au](http://www.wasba.com.au) for information.

Movements on the stallion front, which may affect your choice of stallion, are shown below (WA based sires in red). **PLEASE BE AWARE** that where a stallion stands can affect the scheme that your foal will be eligible for, and you should check the conditions of the various schemes (like Vicbred and the Queensland and NSW schemes) to ensure that you are getting what you expect.

**ARTESIAN** (Artiscape o/o Hula Dancer by Falcon Seelster) has been purchased and will **stand in WA**. Artesian is the sire of WA millionaire David Hercules 1:52.7 \$1,252,269.

**PET ROCK USA** (Rocknroll Hanover out of Casual Beauty by Artsplace) 1:48 \$1,984,204 after one season at Yirribee in NSW, Pet Rock is moving to Empire in Victoria for his second ever season.

**WESTERN EDITION USA** (Western Hanover out of Perfect Profile by Nihilator) is moving from Queensland to **Herron in WA** for owner Neven Botica. Western Edition is a half brother to the all-conquering **Art Major** and **Perfect Art** (sire of Slipnslide 1:54.2 \$1,157,489 and I Am Sam 1:54.4 \$531,702). Western Edition took a record of 1:51.8 and is the sire of 3yo Queensland Triad winner Wicked Style 1:55.7 \$221,295 and 2yo Queensland Triad winner Western Mail 1:53.5 \$178,528.

- **HURRIKANE KINGCOLE USA** (Cams Card Shark out of Blazing Yankee by Western Ideal) 1:47.3 \$582,807 is standing at Egmont Park in Queensland.
- **SUNSHINE BEACH USA** (Somebeachsomewhere out of Light Up by Artsplace) 1:47.8 \$977,438 is standing at Alabar in New Zealand.
- **SWEET LOU USA** (Yankee Cruiser out of Sweet Future by Falcons Future) 1:47.8 \$3,478,894 is standing at Woodlands Stud in New Zealand.

## **MEMORABLE MOMENTS IN JULY**

- ♣ Repeating the great results in the \$100,000 Westbred Classics run on 3 July for the 2 and 3yos, with some very happy connections of the winners **Johnny Disco** (Jeremes Jet), **Dodolicious** (Bettors Delight), **Bettor Reward** (Bettors Delight) and **Once Bitten** (Four Starzzz Shark). Congratulations to everyone involved;
- ♣ **David Hercules** (Artesian) impressively winning the \$50,000 Pinjarra Cup in 1:54.7 over the 2692m;
- ♣ **Dodolicious** an impressive winner of the \$35,000 Gold Bracelet for the 2yo fillies after her win the previous week in the \$100,000 Westbred Classic for 2yo Fillies;
- ♣ **Dodolicious** and **Sheer Rocknroll** (Rocknroll Hanover) running great races in the \$125,000 Golden Slipper to take the minor places;
- ♣ The very positive comments received about the Friday night races for the Westbred 3yo C0s to give them a chance to collect their first win and 3yo Bonuses before they turn four.

## **BREEDER OF THE MONTH – June**

**Another** interesting month, **but Congratulations** to our **Breeder of the Month for June, Ross Torre's Royalstar Pty Ltd**. Ross bred 7 winners in the month including Tuxedo Tour and Oaksana Boy (both by Northern Luck and Where Dreams Grow (Allamerican Ingot). However the monthly award is for the efforts of 4yo gelding **Choccy Mac** (Barnett Hanover out of Maid For Life by Safely Kept).

**Choccy Mac** had his first start for new trainer Justin Prentice in May after a 9 month break from racing. This was a win followed by a third, with the next race being a win at Bunbury over the mile distance in 1:55.7, 4 seconds better than his previous best time. The first quarter of 27.9 was the fastest of the race, and after settling

one out and two back **Choccy Mac** was four wide into the final turn and sprinted past the race leader to win by over 5m, last quarters in 28.8 and 28.4.

Choccy Mac is a half brother to four other winners including **Dredlock Rockstar** (Northern Luck) 1:54.9, 13 wins \$131,291. **Maid For Life** (dam of Choccy Mac) is a full sister to **Bank The Money** 31 wins and \$152,969.

Congratulations to Ross, and Choccy Mac's connections.

## **WA BASED SIRES – June**

In June the progeny of 18 WA based sires produced 27 individual winners of 32 races including 1 deadheat. On top of the list was **Northern Luck** (5 winners of 6 races), then followed Rich And Spoilt (4 winners of 4 races) and **Allamerican Ingot** (3 winners of 4 races). The dual winners were Massive Attack (Advance Attack), Honey And Lime (Allamerican Ingot), Gives Me Chills (Northern Luck) and Rich Yankee (Yankee Sensation). The standouts in the younger brigade were 2yo Rich Yankee, and 3yo Massive Attack.

It was another good month, with 7 West Sired winners at Friday night metropolitan meetings (run at Bunbury) in June. Congratulations to the breeders and connections of the West Sired winners (3 are mentioned under the fillies and mares):

- ♣ **Rich Yankee (Yankee Sensation)**, breeders Karen and Trevor Ness, A and B Ness, easily won the \$100,000 Pearl Classic in 1:57.9 with final quarters 28.2 and 27.7;
- ♣ **Captain Oats (Rich And Spoilt)** breeders Harry Capararo and Jean Wauters, was a comfortable winner of the \$25,000 Gerard Lighting 3yo C/G West Sired Pace over 2100m, excellent last quarters of 28.8 and 27.7;
- ♣ **Out Back Joe (Northern Luck)** owner/breeder Clive Stevens, took the short way home in the sprint lane to win the \$17,500 NHP Pace for M0-M2 pacers; and
- ♣ **Moonlight Rockhole (Northern Luck)**, breeder Royalstar Pty Ltd, won the Westbred Pathway over the stayers distance of 2569m.

## **WESTBRED WINNERS – June**

Westbreds won 93 (50.3%) of the 185 races run in the month of June including 1 dead heat. This is higher than May (43.9%) and very comparable to the 52.5% winners in April 2015. It is also an improvement on June 2014 (44.8%). There were 28 Westbred races run, the same figure as May 2015. We are certainly keen to see the Westbred races on the program, and they are proving to be attractive races.

Of the sires based outside WA, the sires of Westbreds that did best were **Bettors Delight** (6 winners of 8 races including dual winners Dodolicious and Bettor Reward), and **Four Starzzz Shark** (4 winners of 4 races). Full brothers Lightning Jolt (2yo) and Mynameskenny (3yo) won for **Village Jolt**.

The Bunbury track proved to be very friendly to our Westbreds, with 15 individual Westbreds winning 15 (37.5%) of the races at the "Metropolitan" stakes meetings.

Congratulations to the breeders and connections of these 15 Westbreds. Four of the winners are mentioned in the WA bases Sires section and 6 in the Fillies and Mares section. The other 5 Westbred winners were:

- ♣ **Black Aquila (Totally Ruthless)** breeder Total Strategy Pty Ltd, won the \$18,000 IGA Stores Pace for M1-M3, last half in 57.5;
- ♣ **Macon Georgia (Mach Three)** owner/breeder Glen Smith, won his second race in a row with a win in the \$17,500 Sealanes Pace for M0, last quarter in 27 flat;
- ♣ **Twelve Bells (Blissfull Hall)** owner/breeder Geoff Scott, after two successive seconds won a Pathway in 1:58.9; and
- ♣ **Real Zeal (Real Desire)** breeders Harry Capararo and Estate of K Keys, won a Westbred Pathway over 2100m, last half in 57.2;
- ♣ Well related **Hotshot Hall (Blissfull Hall)** breeders/part owners Neville, Mary and Vanessa Brockman, also won a Westbred Pathway.

## ***HOW DID THE FILLIES AND MARES GO (June)***

Overall fillies and mares won 48 (25.9%) of the 185 races run in June - 16 (8.6%) of these races were open races and the remaining 32 (17.3%) races were restricted to fillies/mares. There were 11 (6 2yo and 5 3yo) age restricted races, with the remaining 21 being open to Fillies and Mares. There were several Listed and Group fillies or fillies/mares races in the month, including the \$25,000 The Lombardo Final, the \$25,000 West-Sired Classic for the 3yo fillies and the \$100,000 Del Basso Smallgoods Diamond Classic Final.

In percentage terms the total number of fillies and mares winning in June 2015 is above our current target of 25% but well down on the May figure of 32.1%. It is one higher in number of races won than June 2014.

There are opportunities for 3CO 3yo fillies in July and August to get them Westbred bonus, first win bonus and Breeder Bonus opportunities before they turn four. There are also improved opportunities for fillies/mares in the September/October program compared to last year, to enable more connections of fillies and mares to benefit. These races are being programmed to meet what you need to keep your fillies and mares racing successfully, so we are keen for full advantage to be taken of them.

The Westbred fillies and mares won 27 (19 F/M and 8 open) races in June, which is the lowest monthly figure since October 2014 (also 27). There were 5 races restricted to Westbred fillies and mares – thanks to **Pinjarra**, **Narrogin** and **Wagin**, These clubs also featured last month.

At Gloucester Park (run at Bunbury) Friday night meetings 11 Mares won 12 metro races, including a dead heat involving Major Reality and Baileys Gold in a \$17,500 3yo fillies event. Congratulations to the connections of all the fillies and mares who won at a metropolitan stakes meeting during June. Going against the above trend for the Westbred fillies and mares, 6 of the metropolitan winners were Westbred:

- ♥ **Bethany Aitch (Four Starzzz Shark)** breeder David Young, won the \$100,000 Diamond Classic after taking the sprint lane option, impressive in a 1:57.7 mile rate;
- ♥ **Lady Willoughby (Allamerican Ingot)**, breeder Allwood Stud Farm, won the \$25,000 Lumex Electrical 3yo Fillies West Sired Pace over 2100m, last quarter in 27.5 and winning margin 7m;
- ♥ **Hoylakes Firstlady (Artesian)** breeder Mike Howie, was an excellent winner of the \$25,000 Lombardo Mares Final, mile rate 1:57.8 and last quarters in 27.9 and 28.4;
- ♥ **Sheer Rocknroll (Rocknroll Hanover)**, breeder Allwood Stud Farm, won a \$17,500 2yo fillies race;
- ♥ **Where Dreams Grow (Allamerican Ingot)**, breeder Royalstar Pty Ltd, won Heat 2 of the Lombardo Mares Series last quarters 27.8 and 28 flat; and
- ♥ **Delightful Jade (Bettors Delight)**, breeder Melissa Howie, won a Westbred Pathway in 1:55.3, last quarters in 28.7 and 28.4.

There were also some impressive mile rates by the girls in the country, with Massive Attack (Advance Attack) 1:54.9, Dodolicious (Bettors Delight) 1:56.8, Honey And Lime (Allamerican Ingot) 1:57 and Secret Splendour (Sutter Hanover) 1:57.4 over the 1684m at Pinjarra.

Some of you may have read the article concerning the Tasmanian governments decision to reduce funding to the racing industry even though they had promised to maintain the funding levels – all Tasmanian stakemoney has been cut as a result. Promises can be broken. Even guarantees can be broken.

Make sure this does not happen to you. Members of parliament depend on you for their vote so make sure they are representing YOU in parliament. Ask your local member what he is going to do with his vote if there is a vote on the sale of the TAB in Parliament, then **tell him what you are going to do with your vote.**

If you have opportunity to meet the Minister, make sure he understands your view and put your point across. Do not let the situation in Tasmania happen in WA, where promises and guarantees have been broken within a short timeframe.
