BREEDER OF THE MONTH – August

Congratulations to our **Breeder of the Month for August, Reg Smallacombe**. Reg bred 2yo gelding **Alfs Odyssey** (Dawn Ofa New Day out of Dee Jay Dana by Artesian) who wins the award this month for his win at Bunbury over the mile distance, rating 1:56.9.

This was his second win from 7 starts, with 2 placings and \$26,411 in stakes. His first win was in a Heat of the Pearl, running incredible last quarters of 27.7 and 27.9. He ran third in the \$100,000 Pearl Final but was extremely unlucky to get a flat tyre during the running of the race, making it very difficult to catch top 2yo and winner Rich Yankee, who was running his last quarters in 28.2 and 27.7.

Alfs Odyssey is the first foal from his unraced dam, Dee Jay Dana, whose grand-dam produced Mardie One (Safely Kept) 1:59.5, 16 wins \$104,647 and Five Hundred More (Fake Left) 1:57.3, 12 wins and \$151,269. Alfs Odyssey looks to have a bright future. Congratulations Reg and "Alf".

WA BASED SIRES – August

In August the progeny of 16 WA based sires produced 25 individual winners of 28 races. **Northern Luck** was way ahead (6 winners of 7 races, with **Barnett Hanover** next with 2 winners of 3 races. The dual winners were Choccy Mac (Barnett Hanover), The Revolution (Northern Luck) and Hells Kitchen (Parsons Den).

August was similar to the previous month, with only 4 West Sired being winners at the metropolitan front meetings at Gloucester Park. Congratulations to the breeders and connections of the West Sired winners (3 are mentioned under the fillies and mares):

- ♣ **Bhagwan (Rich And Spoilt)** owner/breeders N Warren, E Barrett and D McAuliffe, ran a super fast 1:55.9 to win a Pathway over 1730m.

WESTBRED WINNERS – August

Westbreds won 70 (40.9%) of the 171 races run in August. This is higher than the previous month, but lower than August 2014. There were 18 Westbred races run (2 higher than the same month last year). The industry is supporting Westbred races, so if you would like to see more, ask your local club to arrange for them.

Of the sires based outside WA, the sires of Westbreds that did best were **Art Major** and **Bettors Delight** (both with 4 winners of 5 races), followed by **Elsu** (4 winners of 4 races). **Blissfull Hall**, **Ponder** and **Mcardle** produced 2 winners of 3 races. Dual winners were The Black Cardinal (Mcardle), The Thinking Man (Ponder), Mistress Bliss (Blissfull Hall), Just Jamie (Bettors Delight) and Catastrophic Event (Art Major).

Not a good month, with only 7 individual Westbreds winning 7 (17.50%) of the races at the "Metropolitan" stakes meetings.

Congratulations to the breeders and connections of these 7 Westbreds. One of the winners is mentioned in the WA bases Sires section and 5 in the Fillies and Mares section. The other Westbred winner was:

- ♣ **Truth Without Fear (Tell All)** owner/breeder Allwood Stud Farm, won one of the Westbred 3yo 3CO events in a nice 1:58.7, with his connections taking home around \$12,000 for winning an \$8,500 race.

HOW DID THE FILLIES AND MARES GO (August)

Overall fillies and mares won 43 (25.1%) of the 171 races run in July - 16 (9.4%) of these races were open races and the remaining 27 (15.8%) races were restricted to fillies/mares. There were 9 (3 2yo and 6 3yo) age restricted races. There were some races restricted to mares only, including the \$14,999 WASBA/Allwood Stud Farm Virgil Queen Celebration Pace for the M0 mares.

In percentage terms the total number of fillies and mares winning in August 2015 met our target of 25% and was 11 higher than the equivalent month last year.

Thanks again to Gloucester Park Harness Racing for facilitating the opportunities for 3CO 3yo fillies in August to give them a chance at the Westbred bonus, first win bonus and Breeder Bonus dollars before they turn four.

The next three months sees improved racing opportunities for fillies and mares, to give your fillies and mares a chance for racing success, stake earnings and Epona Credits. Look for these opportunities.

The Westbred fillies and mares won 20 (16 F/M and 4 open) races in August, consistent with the low number for July and the same period last year. There were 5 races restricted to Westbred fillies and/or mares – thanks to Gloucester Park, Northam, Pinjarra and Bunbury.

At Gloucester Park Friday metropolitan stakes' meetings, 7 Mares won 9 races, with all but two of these winners (Jungle Jewel and Millwood Faith) being Westbred. Of note is the effort of NZ mare Jungle Jewel, who won 3 Gloucester Park races in the month.

Congratulations to the connections of all the fillies and mares who won at a metropolitan stakes meeting during July. The Westbred fillies/mares were:

- ♥ **Artistic Edge (Artistic Fella)** owner/breeder Colleen Lindsay, took the inside running and ran home strongly to win the 3yo 3C0 fillies event by 3m, taking home around \$15,000 in the process.
